The annual meeting of the Association of Korean Agricultural, Biological and Food Engineers (AKABFE) was held on Tuesday, July 14, 2020, during the American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers (ASABE)'s Annual International Meeting in a virtual environment. A total of 20 members attended the AKABFE annual meeting held online as a live session, which lasted for one hour. At this meeting, we discussed the AKABFE business and plans for next year's AKABFE meeting, followed by a session to introduce professional careers in the U.S. and Canada. The participants agreed on the need to prepare for AKABFE meeting in advance if the 2021 ASABE meeting goes virtual due to COVID-19. The participants also made suggestions on the online formats and meeting schedules of a student research spotlight contest to be held in 2021.

Award/Honor Announcements



Dr. Byoung-Kwan Cho, Professor of the Department of Biosystems Machinery Engineering, Chungnam National University, received the 2020 Hwa-Nong Award (화농상) in recognition of his significant contribution to R&D in agricultural and life sciences. Professor Cho's work on Line-scan imaging analysis for rapid viability evaluation of white-fertilized-egg embryos was recognized as his major research accomplishment for the award. Professor Cho 's publication record of over 90 papers in the past five years and hist leading role in the field of non-destructive sensing for agricultural and food applications were also recognized with this award.
